"Thing on a Thing" is created!

A top ten Private Equity firm has acquired seven companies now under the new brand. On inception **"Thing on a Thing"** becomes a 5 B USD \$ Company serving everyone from the the fortune 25 to Mom and Pop creators of products and services. All need their products and services connected to the IoT to compete in the modern Digital Economy. **'Thing on a Thing'** could be on anything from a valve, to a toaster, to a heart monitor.

The formerly disparate People, Process, and Technologies now have a common goal!





"Connect yesterday to today!"

The cyber-physical systems organization designs a device that can connect anything to the IoT. Software Engineering creates the interface APIs in a standard format. Manufacturing builds the physical connector and loads the custom operating system. The Services organization gathers requirements, deploys and configures the tool. The Support Organization troubleshoots problems for customers. Sales people bring in new ideas from customers and sell our products and services. Shares Services teams include Legal, Security, User Experience, L10N (Translation), and the full set of shared services organizations expected in a very large company.

The merged companies are currently aligned functionally. The CEO is willing to realign to value streams and has experience with lean transformations. Information must flow across silos. This is new to the companies, especially Manufacturing and Engineering which were stand alone companies. The CFO is keen to implement a Low-Code platform to digitize the company's workflow and data movement.

The merged companies have capacity to build the various 'Things on Things.' Sales and Marketing however need early and frequent access to prime the markets.

Though the company is relatively small, ~30K employees, the scope is very global. Private Equity is willing to spend money to make money. Life cycles from waterfall to 'fringe agile exploratory' are expected. The market is competitive, speed to market is critical!




